
- 1. To be eligible for the scheme applicants must be a member of Tara and District Credit Union Ltd.
- 2. Applicants must be commencing a full time PLC, Certificate, Diploma or Degree Course, at any University, IT or approved Third Level Institution.
- 3. Applicants must complete the application form which requires verification of their attendance at their relevant 3rd Level College.
- 4. The Bursary will be paid at a rate of €1000 per annum, payable in 2 x €500 instalments, for a maximum of 3 years.
- 5. Payment of the Bursary is dependent on the student maintaining satisfactory progress.
- Decision of the Board of Directors will be final.
- 7. Closing Date for receipt of applications Friday 11th October 2024 at 4.30pm.
- 8. Once an applicant has been successful in obtaining a Bursary, they will not be eligible for a Bursary again.
